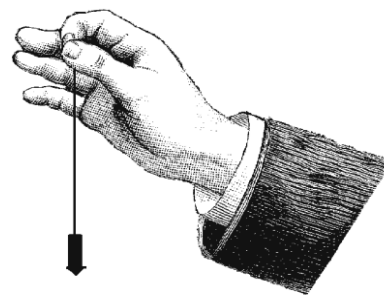

## PRESIDENT'S REPORT



By the time you read this we will already be in the Year of the Fire Horse which started on February 17.

What is the Year of the Fire Horse?

A fire horse year is often described as being fast-moving and high-energy. The last fire horse was in 1966 when China's Cultural Revolution began, a time of political and social upheaval. This could mean we are in for a bumpy roller coaster ride this year. It could bring extreme success but can also be an extremely challenging time period.

These four words should be forbidden inside your home. The words you speak inside your house are powerful energetic commands that can either bless or destroy your home. You may think this is an exaggeration, but later, don't say no one warned you.

The first word that needs to go is disgrace, when you say "This place is a disgrace," you are declaring chaos. You are decreeing disorder, and what is declared with intensity tends to settle in. Things start breaking, plans get delayed, situations go wrong, and you don't even realize it's because it was said repeatedly.

Second word: miserable. That word carries lack. It carries scarcity. It carries heaviness. Then money starts running short, opportunities get blocked, doors seem to close, and the person says it's a coincidence.

Third word: blame. "It's your fault. It's my fault, It traps energies in the past. Saying this impacts your relationship with yourself and with the people around you.

Fourth word: hate. When you say, "I hate this, I hate that," the word hate does not just float in the air. It activates invisible tension. It creates accumulated irritation. The small things turn into disproportionate explosions, arguments begin over nothing, and no one understands why. Understand this once and for all: your home listens to what you repeat, and everything that is repeated gains strength. If you want a protected home, start by protecting your tongue. I choose words of blessing" as a confirmation of what you desire for your life and your home.

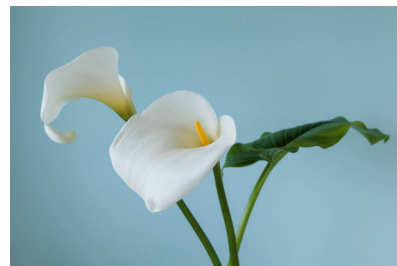
